Subject: **Filing a lawsuit against IBC**

Further to what is stated in Section 18.1.4(3) of Chapter A of the Company's periodic report for 2024, regarding the Company's commitment under the IRU agreements with IBC Israel Broadband Company (2013) Ltd. ("IBC") and regarding the deployment of IBC's infrastructure ("the New Deployment") and dispute between the Company and IBC, concerning the new deployment the Company updates that on May 15, 2025, the Company filed a lawsuit in the Tel Aviv-Jaffa District Court against IBC. In this lawsuit, the company requested, among other things, that the court declare and order that IBC's claims that the Company is obligated to purchase infrastructure lines in the scope, timing, and amounts demanded by IBC are not accepted and that IBC's interpretation in this matter is incorrect and should not be followed; that IBC is prevented from acting according to its incorrect interpretation as mentioned; and that IBC is prevented from using self-remedies under the IRU agreement, including being prevented from acting to cancel the agreement and/or stop and/or suspend and/or delay any of the services under it and/or being prevented from acting to forfeit the guarantees (or any of them) provided by the Company under the said agreement (for details regarding the said guarantees, see section 8.1.4(1) of Part A of the periodic report).
